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The Correspondent of Bolton School, H.No: 219/B, Opp Tivoli Gardens Exclusive, Bolton Road, Secunderabad, Tirumalgherry Mandal, Hyderabad Dist, for the Period 2018-2019 to 2022-2023, has submitted the proposal through the Deputy Inspector of Schools, Tirumalgherry Mandal, for granting of E.T.R. for Classes I to VII (E/M) for the year **2018-2019 to 2022-2023**, in the references 4th cited.

After careful examination of the references read above and interms of G.O.Ms.no.1 Edn. Dt.01-1-1994 read with G.O. Ms. No. 52 Edn. Dt. 28-2-98, G.O.Ms.No. 23 Dt.10-3-99, G.O.Ms.No.41, Dt.11-05-2006, G.O.Ms.No.74, Dt.02-07-2006 and G.O.Ms.No.58, Dt.13-07-2006 and G.O.Ms.No.88, Dt.07-07-2008 and as per the report submitted by the Deputy Inspector of Schools, Tirumalgherry Mandal, in the reference 4th cited, the competent authority has accorded E.T.R. for **Classes I to VII (E/M) from the year 2018-2019 to 2022-2023**, in respect of the Bolton School, H.No: 219/B, Opp Tivoli Gardens Exclusive, Bolton Road, Secunderabad, Tirumalgherry Mandal, Hyderabad Dist, Subject to the co-ndition that the management shall fulfill the following conditions.

1. That Class rooms with an area of not less than 240 Sq.feet at the rate of one for each section in case of Upper Primary and Secondary sections at the rate of one for every 40 students in case of primary sections shall be provided.
2. That adequate accommodation for the staff, Library and Laboratories shall be provided.
3. That adequate sanitary facilities and water including drinking water shall be provided.
4. That adequate furniture, Library books, Lab equipment and play material shall be provided.
5. That sufficient number of qualified staff shall be appointed.
6. That the educational agencies shall prescribe the scales of pay to the teaching and non-teaching staff.
7. That the educational institutions shall serve the needs of the locality.
8. That the Educational Institutions shall adopt the curriculum, syllabus, text books and work books prescribed by the government.
9. That the Educational Institutions shall follow the school timings mid-term holidays and vacation as prescribed by the government.
10. That the administrative report and the audited statement of accounts of the school duly attested by the Chartered accountant for every financial year shall be submitted to the District Educational Officer, latest by September.
11. That the list of the Governing Body shall be furnished to the District Educational Officer every year.
12. That the pay structures/fee structures fixed by the governing body shall be Submitted and get it approved in the District Educational Officer.
13. That the Educational Institutions shall provide facilities for teaching telugu as First/Second Language in the school.
14. That under aged children shall not be admitted or promoted to any class.

- f) To provide training to the staff so that they discharge their responsibilities properly and promptly to protect children from any form of abuse.
- g) The school shall constitute Committees for redressal of the Public/ Staff/Parents/ Students grievances, Internal Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment and Committees under POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offence) Act, 2012 and details of these Committees along with contact details shall be displayed prominently on School Notice Board and conspicuously on the School Website for the information of all the stakeholders.
- h) To engage lady conductors and provide separate toilets for drivers and the house keeping team etc.
- i) Presence of a female attendant to be ensured for nursery to Pre-Primary sections outside the wash rooms/toilets/changing rooms in all the schools.
- j) The children travelling by school bus should be the responsibility of the school from the time they board the school bus till they are handed over to their parents.
- k) That a person employed with the schools, if found guilty/charged of any criminal offence / antecedents, besides Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POSCO) and Juvenile Justice Act, should be immediately terminated.

➤ The Educational Agency should implement the Model Education Code prepared by National University for Educational Planning and Administration in 2015.

➤ The Educational Agency should implement comprehensive set of Guidelines on the Safety and Security of Children issued by the Ministry of Human Resource and Development (MHRD), Govt. of India communicated vide D.O.Lr.No.10-11/2014-EE-4 of Addl. Secretary (SE) dt.09.10.2014.


➤ The Educational Agency should implement the Guidelines for Safe and Effective use of Internet & Digital Technologies in schools and school buses issued by CBSE vide Circular No.Acad-32/2017, dated 18.08.2017 communicated by MHRD, Govt. of India.

➤ The Educational Agency should Implement the Regulatory Guidelines for the private 'Play Schools' framed by National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPNR) communicated vide D.O.No.2501/13/2016-17/NCPNR/RTE/49579, dated 21.12.2016

➤ The Educational Agency should implement the Guidelines on School Safety Policy, 2016 prepared by the National Disaster Management Authority, Govt. of India.

➤ The Educational Agency shall not expand the school building Horizontal & Vertically without prior permission of authorities concerned.

The E.T.R. issued with subject to the condition, the management should submit the NOC from the Traffic department within three (03) months other wise now issued orders is liable for cancel.
